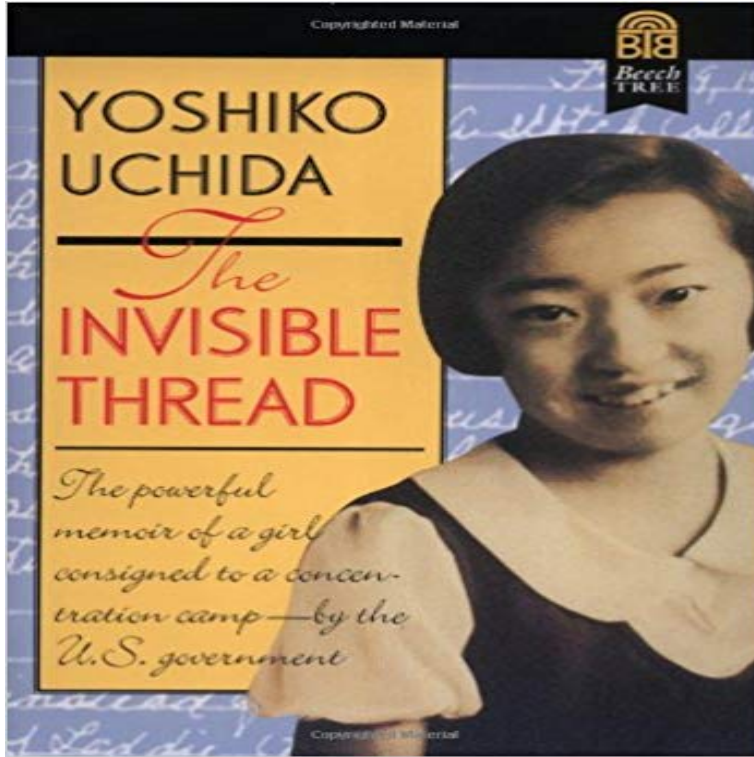


# The Invisible Thread
