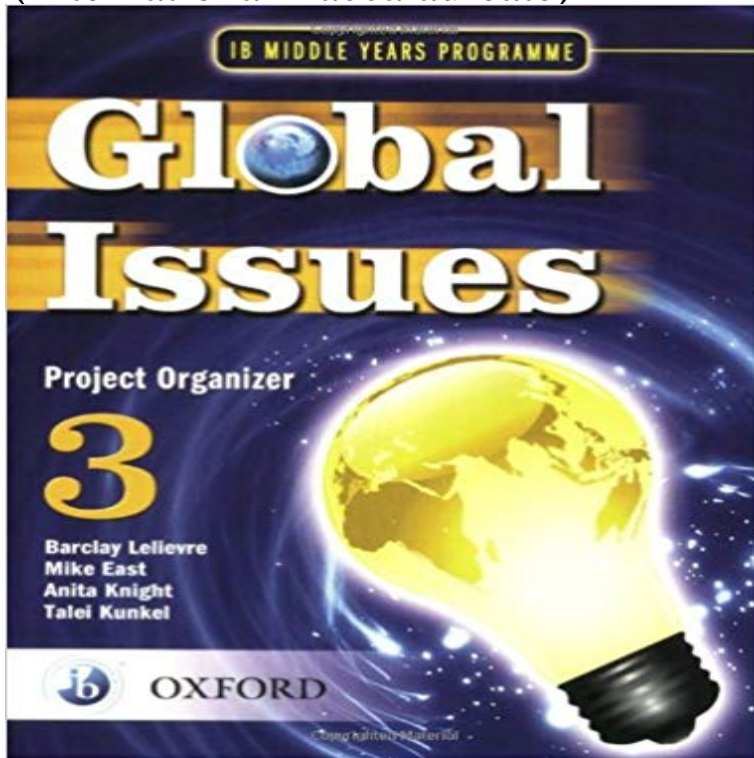


IB Global Issues Project Organizer 3: Middle Years Programme (International Baccalaureate)
