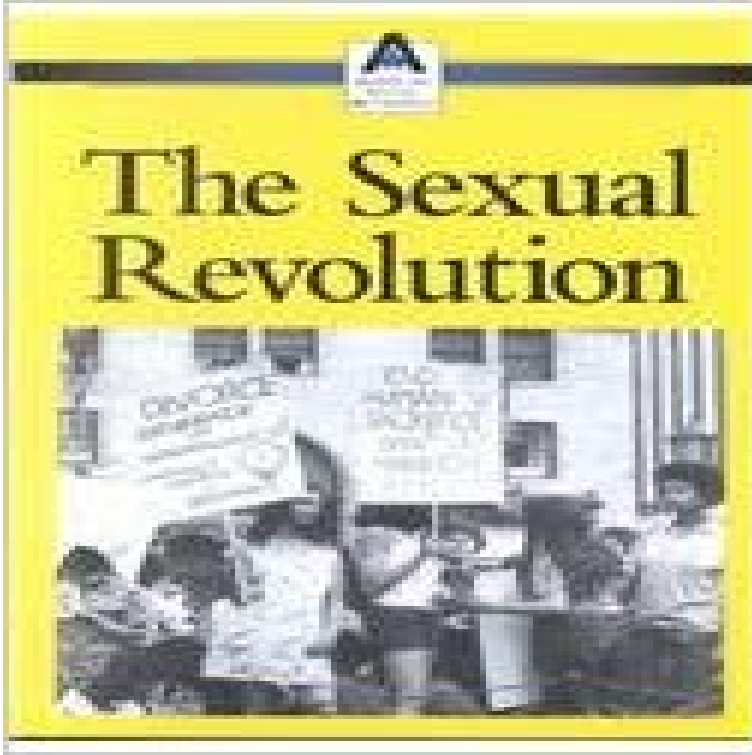


# The Sexual Revolution (American Social Movements (Hardcover))
