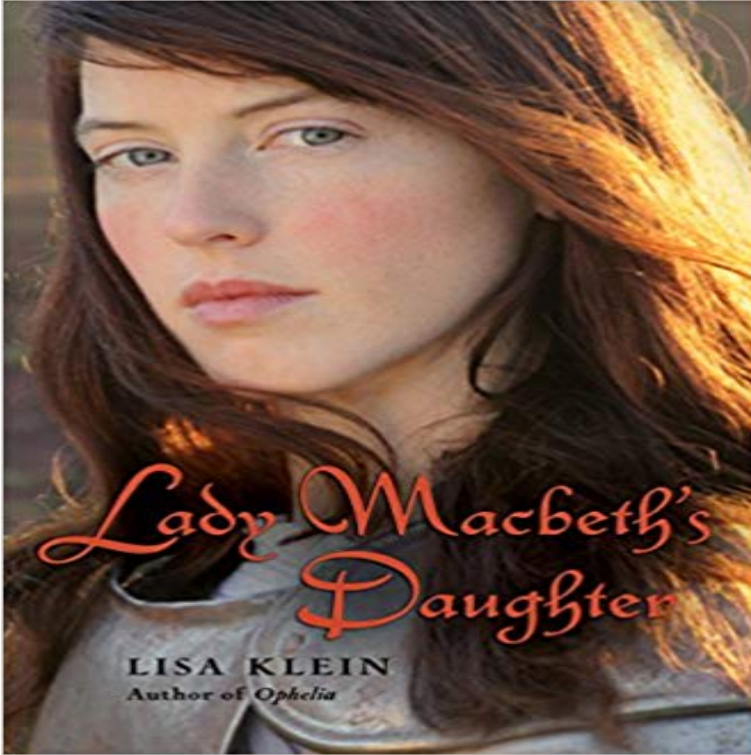


Lady Macbeths Daughter
