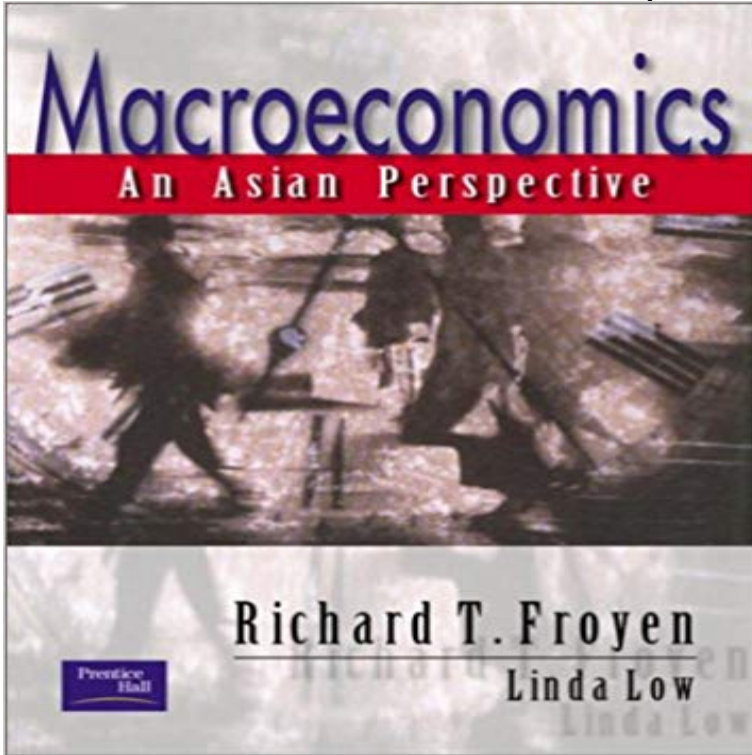


Macroeconomics: An Asian Perspective
