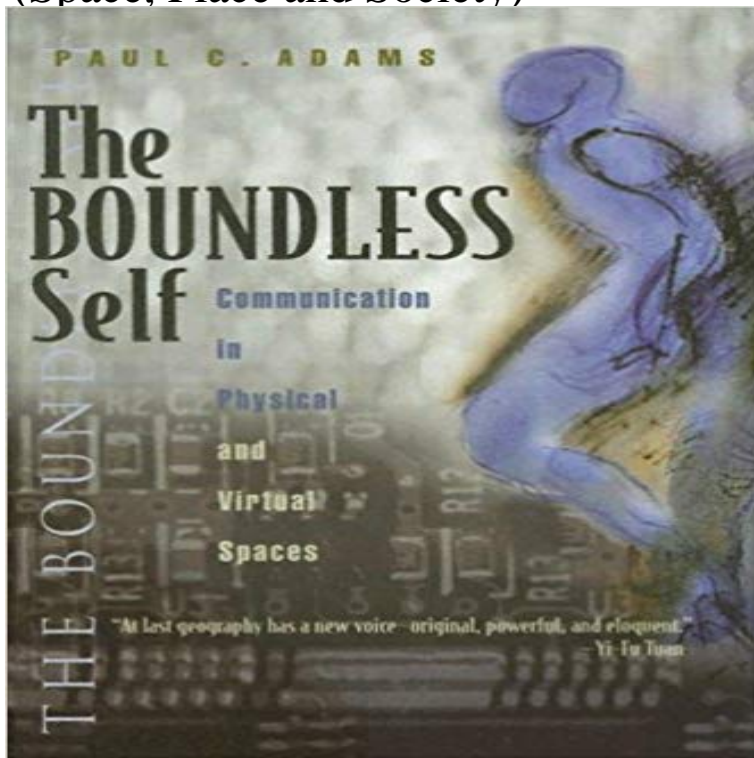


The Boundless Self: Communication in Physical and Virtual Spaces (Space, Place and Society)
