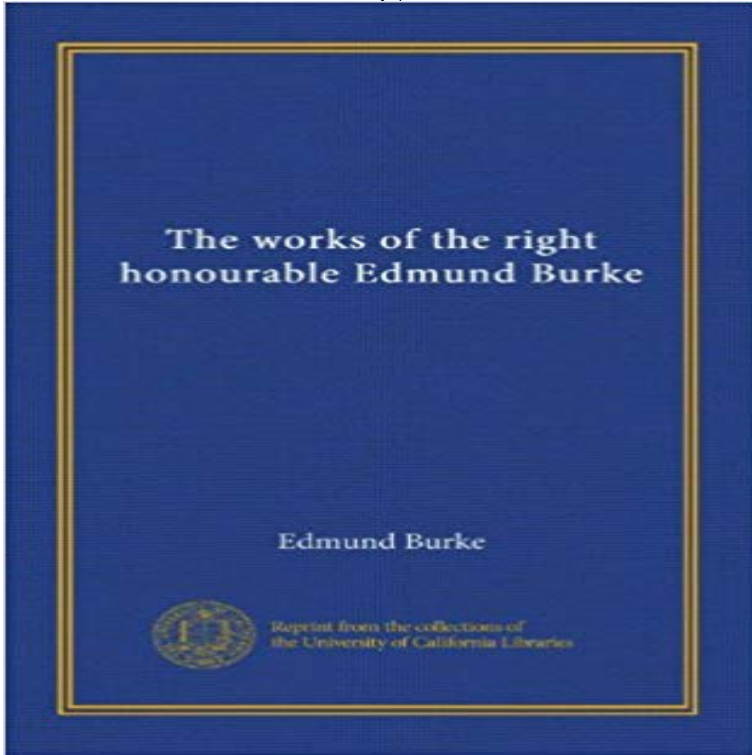


## The works of the right honourable Edmund Burke (v.14)
